I am 24 years old, I have been married three years and I just gave birth to my first child on May 2nd. I am currently unemployed, my husband is employed part time. My husband and I live with my mother which has been the most important person in mine and my husbands life since my dad was killed.

I was only 16 years old when my dad was killed and I will never forget that day. When he was killed I attended Shadow Ridge High School and was in the 11th grade. I had pretty good grades and enjoyed school but after my dad died I struggled to go back to school I just couldn't cope socially with all the questions from my friends about my dads death. I started skipping classes then skipping school completely. My mother had a really good friend that worked at the Board of Education that told her about the Adult Education program they offered that she thought would be perfect for me. The Counselor at the Board of Education reviewed my transcripts and realized I was only a few classes short of having a enough credits to graduate. I completed the three classes within months and ended up graduating a year earlier than I would have if I would attended regular school. I started classes at CSN right away after I received my diploma but then things started to fall apart for me quickly. I don't think I ever dealt with my dads death and after

graduating and starting College it all crashed down on me. I went down a hard path for about a year that without my mother, counseling, God and Tyler which is now my husband I would have never made it through alive. Since that time I have worked in pet grooming, kennel management and focused mainly on working my program, bettering myself as a person and now raising my son. This scholarship would give me the financial assistance I need to attend a school to help me attain a career that would eventually allow me to work from home and maybe even start my own medical billing and coding company in the future. I want to make sure I am as good a parent to my son as my Dad was for me. My life changed forever when my Dad was killed but I know he is proud of who I have become. Thank you for your consideration.
